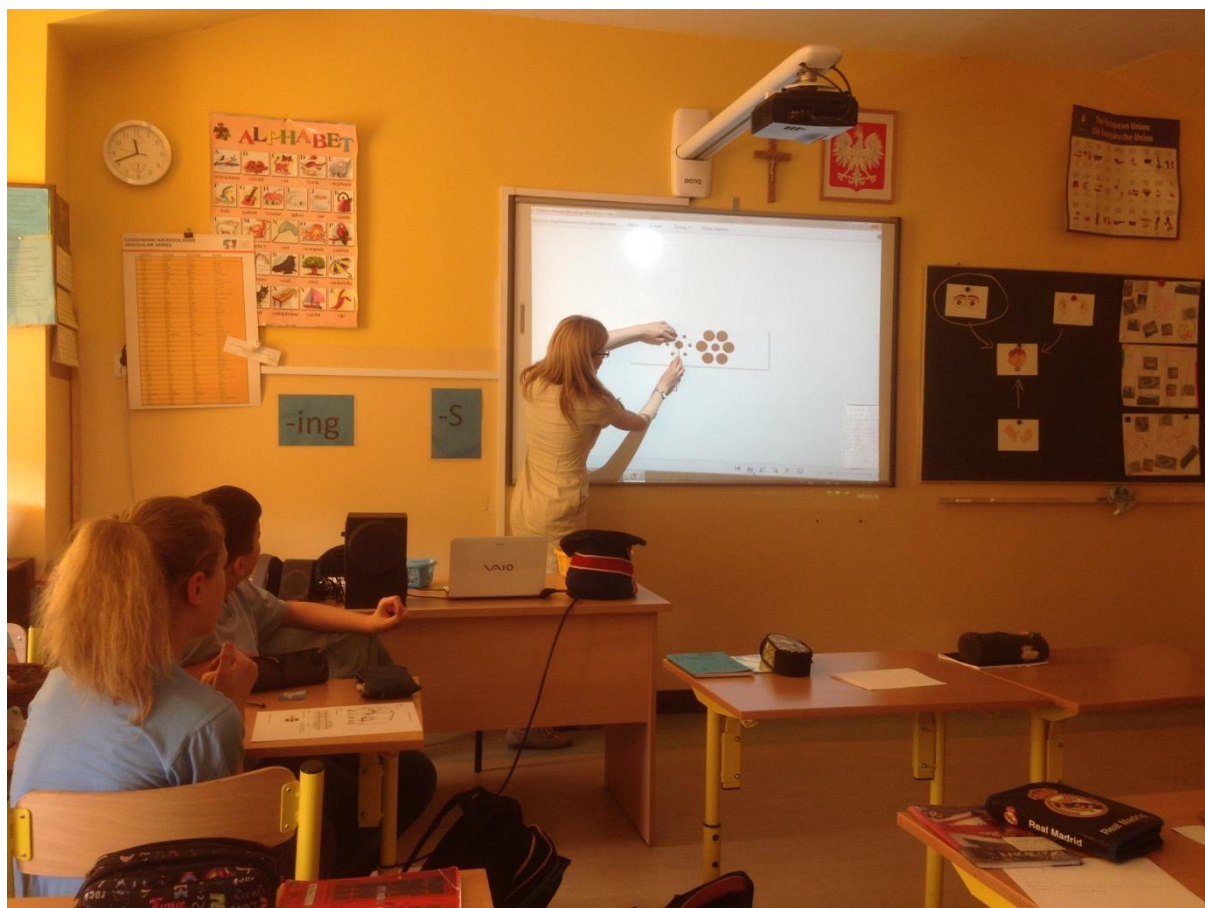
- Five days of learning, teaching and training course: didactic methods for teaching children with mixed-up abilities, preparing a lesson and testing it in the classes
- Overviewing of what has been done so far and what should be done till the next meeting
- Assessment and evaluation: filling in the first year Evaluation Manual
- Updating the project website
- Defining the framework and the items to insert in the Annual Inclusive Plan thanks to an exchange of proposal in E-twinning platform
- Presentation of the project to school community



2 training sessions were planned. One was connected with the techniques and methods that shape students' memory, concentration and attention. It was conducted by Beata Mrosek – the Polish coordinator. The second session was connected with the observation of how using those techniques by teachers' works in a classroom or during individual lessons.



A discussion followed. The feedback from the observing teachers was very positive. Additionally, all partners presented a project task connected with the celebrating Children's Day in their own countries. All the gathered information was very useful and interesting.



The visiting partners had also a chance to see an integrated kindergarten and visit J. A. Komeński State Higher Vocational School. While planning the visit, we also prepared activities for partners together with our students. So, there was a talent show, football and volleyball matches.
